Greetings,

In Saline, we strive to provide our students with learning experiences that will enhance their motivation, provide opportunities for collaboration and improve our overall academic strategy. Our Credit-Based Summer School Program is available for students who are seeking credit recovery, have ambitions of credit advancement and/or may simply be interested in taking classes outside of the traditional school calendar.

We are excited to expand student choices this summer with new course opportunities, including:

- **Physical Education I** (required for graduation, .5 credit)
- **Physical Education II** (provided as an option for the second required half credit of PE, .5 credit)

We will have an AM session combined with PE 1 + 2 students (7AM - 11AM) taught in a condensed, 20-day program that will result in a full trimester credit for your student. Please note, because credit is being issued and clock hours must be met, students enrolled must attend every session to receive credit.
