Provide instructional models that best meet the educational and social/emotional needs of our students




Logically organize our staffing model in a way in which it will allow these instructional models to thrive

OPTION 1: IN-PETZSON INSTRUCTION

Your child will attend, in person, as much as possible, based on local conditions. We are committed to safety protocols being followed. These include consistent mask wearing, social distancing to the best of our ability (which will not always be possible especially in the classroom), frequent hand washing and other hygiene techniques, limited movement throughout hallways, etc.

OPTION 2: DISTANCE LEATENING INSTITUCTION

Your child will receive all of their instruction from one of our teachers in a virtual environment and will not physically be coming to school.



6TH GRADE OPTIONS + CONSIDERATIONS

- 1) There may be students moving from virtual to in-person and in-person to virtual classrooms.
- 2) Class sizes may change as a result of shifting students between instructional models, which could mean increasing class sizes for virtual classrooms.
- 3) Our staffing model is likely to change. We may have some teachers moving to teach in-person who were previously virtual teachers. (6th grade only)
- 4) Although we will try to keep students with their 1st trimester teachers, there will be some instances (in both instructional models) where students may need to move classrooms.
- 5) Our priority is to keep students on the same learning management system they used for the first trimester (Summit Learning or Google Classroom). However, a request for a student to change from virtual to in-person (or vice versa) may result in placing that student in a classroom using a different learning management system.
- 6) Safety is still very important to us. Required mask wearing, frequent hand washing and social distancing, to the best of our ability, will be enforced.



7-12 CONSIDERATIONS

In order to rebuild parts of the schedule to honor parent requests, here are a few considerations.....

- 1) There may be students moving from virtual to in-person and in-person to virtual classrooms.
- 2) Safety is still very important to us. Required mask wearing, frequent hand washing and social distancing, to the best of our ability, will be enforced.
