Saline Alternative High School AER

For the 2016-17 year, no new Priority or Focus Schools were named; some Priority or Focus Schools did exit their status because they met criteria. New Reward schools were identified using school rankings and Beating the Odds Information. A Focus school is one that has a large achievement gap between the highest and lowest achieving 30% of schools. A Priority schools is one whose achievement and growth is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Reward schools is one that has achieved one or more of the following distinctions: top 5% of schools on the

Top-to-Bottom School Rankings, top 5% of schools making the greatest gains in achievement (improvement metric), or "Beating the Odds" by outperforming the school's predicted ranking and/or similar schools. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

The Saline Alternative High School continues to work with a diverse population of students in an ongoing effort to help them to excel. In 2016, the Saline Alternative High School graduated 93% of its eligible seniors.
